

#### Easter: A Celebration of Recovery and Hope

dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found." Luke 15:32

Easter is a time of immense joy, a time to celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. But beyond the celebration, Easter also invites us to reflect deeply on something personal: the recovery of Jesus when we feel we have lost Him.

We live in a time when many feel disconnected from God, a time where the presence and love of Jesus seem distant. The world, in many ways, is losing its connection with God. On the first Easter morning, Mary Magdalene's words, "They have taken away the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they again. have laid Him" (John 20:2), reflect a deep sorrow that empty tomb, echo a question that lingers in our hearts: "Where is my Lord? How did I lose Him?"

There are times in our lives when we feel that absence, when we long for His presence but feel lost or disconnected. In these moments, Easter speaks to us not just about resurrection but also about recovery-the recovery of Jesus in our hearts, even when we feel we have lost Him.

The world today seems to be in a similar state of loss. There is a growing sense of distance from God. Yet, the message of Easter is not only about loss-it is when we think we've lost Jesus, He is always there, waiting to be found again. Even Jesus' closest followers experienced moments of loss. We see this in God waits with open arms to welcome us back, no many examples in the Bible. Judas betrayed Him for thirty pieces of silver and a kiss of deception. Peter, despite his deep love for Jesus, denied Him three times. The Jewish leaders handed Jesus over to be crucified, and Pilate, knowing the truth, washed his hands of responsibility. Even Mary, the mother of Jesus, experienced a moment of loss.

When Jesus was 12 years old, she and Joseph searched for Him, only to find Him after three days in the temple. Mary Magdalene also realized about the loss of Jesus's body on the third day of his crucifixion. The names and days were same, what a co incidence.

"We had to celebrate and be glad, because... he was The story of these losses is not just a part of history; it reflects the human experience. Whether through betrayal, fear, or misunderstanding, all of us have moments where we feel that we have lost Jesus. But what we learn from Easter is that Jesus is not lost forever. Just as Mary Magdalene found Him alive, so too can we find Him again.

> Easter is a celebration of recovery. It reminds us that no matter how far we have drifted, Jesus is always waiting to be found. After His resurrection, Jesus appeared to His disciples in their despair, in their locked rooms, and even on the road to Emmaus. He came to them in their hopelessness and gave them hope. He showed them that no matter how far we fall, we can always find Him

many of us also experience. Her words, spoken at the The resurrection of Jesus offers us the ultimate promise: "I will be with you always, even to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:20). This promise transformed the lives of the disciples. They went from fear and despair to courage and hope. They became bold witnesses of the resurrection, willing to face any hardship because they knew they would never lose Jesus again. This transformation is the essence of Easter. It is the hope that no matter how far we fall, we can always rise again in Christ. Easter calls us to embrace the joy of finding Jesus once again in our lives.

This Easter, let us take a moment to reflect on our own hearts. Have we lost Jesus in the busyness of life, in our about retrieval. The resurrection reminds us that even struggles, or in our doubts? Let us allow the light of the resurrection to shine into the darkness of our hearts and bring us back to Him. Like the father of the prodigal son, matter how far we have strayed.

> Let us celebrate Easter not just as a historical event but as a living reality in our lives. As we recover Jesus in our hearts, we too can experience the transformation that comes with His resurrection. This Easter, may we all find Jesus anew, and may it become a blessed and joyful celebration of His love and grace.

### Path to Heaven (By Nathan Chacko)




