### Mother Mary! Courage in the unknown! Christmas! In God we trust!

Dear Beloved in Christ,

As we step into December, the final month of a blessed and eventful year, my heart is filled with gratitude for God's abundant grace upon CSI Christ Church of Chicago. This year, 2024, marked the 30th Anniversary of the light of Christ in our relationships. As members of our church, and a Ruby Anniversary celebration of God's faithfulness to our existence as a CSI community in this Chicago land.

Looking back, we see the gracious way the Lord Jesus Christ has led us, holding our hands and guiding us step by step. This has been a year of spiritual growth and fellowship. Under the leadership of Mr. Premjith William (Vice President), Mr. Meljo Varghese (Secretary), Mr. Nityan Joy (Treasurer), and the entire executive team, we achieved significant milestones that strengthened our church life. I am particularly thankful for the peace and unity we enjoy as a congregation—a true blessing in these times.

### A New Season: Advent and Transition


