

Let Jesus Be the Guest at Every Feast From Hiding Fish to Fried Fish

Dearly beloved in Christ,

streets of Chicago. Summer brings long, golden days, parks echo with laughter, grills are fired up, and families gather in love. As we enjoy these vibrant days of barbecues, outings, and celebrations, let us pause to ask-is Jesus invited to our summer feasts?

In John 21:1-14, we find the risen Jesus preparing breakfast on the shore of the Sea of Tiberias. He waits for His tired disciples, not with rebuke, but with a warm meal-bread and fish grilled over burning coals. What a Savior we have-one who cares not just for our souls but also for our hunger and weariness. This image of Jesus, cooking and serving, reminds us of other meals in the Scriptures. On the road to Emmaus, the disciples invite Jesus to dinner, and He becomes the host, breaking bread and opening their eyes to His presence (Luke 24:30-31). In Revelation 3:20, Jesus says, "If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me." Jesus doesn't just want to visit our lives -He desires to dine with us, to be present in our ordinary moments, our daily routines, and our joyful celebrations. The wedding in Cana (John 2), where Jesus turned water into wine is another example.

In all these instances, something powerful happens when Jesus is present: meals become miracles, gatherings become holy, Scarcity become abundance, worry become wonder, and water become the best wine ever tasted. As we open our homes and fire up our grills this July, let us also open our hearts and say, "Lord, be our guest." Whether we're around a dinner table, picnic place, or campfire, may Christ be at the center.

From Hiding Fish to Fried Fish

The breakfast on the beach in John 21 was not just about food- it was a quiet, powerful moment of transformation. The disciples had labored all night without catching a single fish. They were still recovering from the trauma of the crucifixion. They had fled, hidden, and lost their confidence. With The month of July is a time when joy spills out onto the ___. Then Jesus appears.

> He tells them to cast their net on the other side—and they catch 153 fish. But more than the miracle of the catch, Jesus invites them to a lesson. Imagine Him smiling and asking, "Is the fish tasty?" The disciples would say yes. And perhaps Jesus would reply, "So will you be—when you stop hiding like these fish and give yourself for the sake of the world."

Just as the fish were caught, cooked, and shared, the disciples were called to come out of hiding and become food for the hungry souls of the world. No longer were they to be the slippery, elusive fish avoiding danger—but transformed, like the grilled fish, to serve, to nourish, to witness.

Later, these same disciples—once fearful and scattered-stood with boldness, preached with fire, and became salt and light to the nations. They gave themselves fully for the Kingdom, and the world tasted their sacrifice.

This summer, as we gather to taste and enjoy the good things of life, let us remember our calling: to surrender ourselves to Christ, that we too may be transformed from hiding to serving—from raw to ready -from ordinary to a flavorful offering for the world. May Jesus be the fire that warms our hearts, the bread that fills our souls, and the guest who transforms our feasts into sacred fellowship.

As many of you know, last year we joyfully celebrated **40 years** of our journey as a **CSI community in this blessed land**. Through God's abundant grace, we remained a **debt-free church**, and once again, we testify to His faithfulness in this new chapter of our church life.

We are glad to share that the **sale of our church property** has been **successfully completed** within just **6-7 months**—a timeline that clearly shows the hand of God at work. Not only was the process smooth, but we also received the **exact amount we had prayerfully asked for**. The **entire amount received** from this sale has been **set apart solely for our future church facility**, where we hope to continue worshipping our Lord together as a community.
