Clouds, Crowns, and Care: The Ascended Christ and the Love of Mothers

As we continue to experience the joy of the Easter season, we are invited to reflect on one of the most significant yet often overlooked events in the life of Jesus Christ-His Ascension into heaven. Occurring forty days after His resurrection, the Ascension is not just a farewell-it is a divine milestone. It marks the completion of Jesus' earthly mission and the beginning of ours.

This year, the month of May brings us a beautiful convergence of two meaningful celebrations: the Ascension of our Lord and Mother's Day. Here at Christ Church of Chicago, we observe Mother's Day on the second Sunday of May-a moment to honor and uplift the women who have shaped our lives with love, strength, and sacrifice. As we reflect on the Ascension, we also give thanks for the faithful witness of mothers who, like Jesus, have journeyed through life giving of themselves for others.

1. The Fulfillment of God's Plan

In Acts 1:9, we read that Jesus "was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid Him from their sight." This moment signals that Christ's earthly mission was complete. From His birth to His resurrection, Jesus fulfilled the will of the Father. The Ascension is not a departure of absence but a declaration of victory—He has defeated sin and death, and our redemption is secure.

For our church, this season also marks a spiritual milestone. We were blessed to walk together through 40 days of Lent with meaningful cottage prayers and a moving Holy Week, culminating in the vespers and Easter joy. Thank you to all who participated so faithfully. Our shared prayers, songs, and reflections deepened our faith and unity as a community. The Ascension reminds us that such journeys are not the end, but preparation for the mission that lies ahead.

2. The Promise of His Return and the Power of Hope

As Jesus ascended, He didn't leave us with sorrow. He left us with a blessing and a promise. "This same Jesus... will come back in the same way you have seen Him go into heaven" (Acts 1:11). His return is our living hope. As we face the uncertainties of life, we do so with the assurance that Christ will return to restore all things.

This hope is something many mothers embody every day. Whether in times of joy or struggle, their love remains steadfast, grounded in faith and patient hope for their children and families. Their resilience reflects the very nature of God's promises-constant, nurturing, and ever faithful.

3. Empowered for Mission: The Role of the Church and Mothers

The Ascension also signals a new chapter for the Church. Though Jesus ascended, He did not leave us powerless. He promised the gift of the Holy Spirit, which we joyfully anticipate on Pentecost. This Spirit empowers each of us to carry on Christ's mission-to bring healing, hope, and love into a world that desperately needs it.

In this calling, we see the sacred role of mothers and women of faith. Their everyday acts of love, wisdom, and strength are living testimonies of the Spirit's work. They are the first teachers of faith to many of us, often sowing the seeds of prayer and devotion into our hearts. On this Mother's Day, let us honor not only our biological mothers but also spiritual mothers—Sunday school teachers, mentors, and elders—who have shaped our walk with God.

Living Between the Cloud and the Promise

The Ascension reminds us that we live in the in-between: between Christ's departure and His promised return. Yet we are not alone. We are a people filled with the Holy Spirit, called to reflect Christ's love in our homes, workplaces, and community.

May this season restore in us a desire to live as witnessesbold in faith, rooted in hope, and active in love. And may we especially give thanks for the mothers and women among us who mirror God's tender care through their faithful lives.

As we move forward, may the joy of Easter, the promise of the Ascension, and the love celebrated on Mother's Day guide us to be a church that lives the Gospel with courage and compassion. Christ has ascended-but His work continues through us.

Let us rise with Him.






