Will You Carry Christ as Mary Did? (Luke 1:26-38)

Dear beloved in Christ,
Wish you all a blessed and grace-filled month of December. As we enter the final month of the year, we thank the Lord who has protected and sustained us through the past eleven months. Now, as a faith community, we turn our hearts toward Christmas—remembering His first coming and renewing our hope in His coming again.

This passage reveals the intimate moment when God invites Mary into His divine plan. Christmas reminds us not only that God came into the world, but that He still asks a question that echoes across generations: “Will you be a mother? A mother of the Son of God? or Is there room for Jesus in your life?” This question continues to speak to us today.

1. Mary’s Yes: A New Dawn for Humanity

The angel’s message to Mary was not merely an announcement but an invitation—an invitation to participate in God’s redeeming work. Mary responded not with full understanding, but with full surrender: “Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word.”

Her “yes” became the hinge on which salvation history turned. It was the moment heaven touched earth, and eternity entered time. Christmas reminds us that God still seeks human hearts willing to say, “Let it be to me according to Your word.”

In Mary’s simple obedience, we see that God does not seek our capability but our availability. God works through ordinary people who open their lives to extraordinary grace.

2. The Deeper Meaning of Motherhood

Motherhood is not defined merely by giving birth; in a world with surrogacy and many complexities, we understand that true motherhood goes beyond delivery—it is the willingness to nurture, protect, carry, give life, and even sacrifice for a child. In the same way, bearing Christ is not a one-time event but a lifelong responsibility. Christmas asks whether we will carry Christ in our hearts, nurture His presence in our thoughts, protect His teachings in our daily decisions, and reflect His life in our relationships and community. Just as Mary made room for Jesus in her body, God asks us today, “Is there room for Me in your heart, your decisions, your priorities, and your home?” If Christ is to be born again in our world, it must begin by being born in us.

3. Preparing Our Hearts for a Meaningful Christmas

As we enter this holy season, let us prepare not only our homes but our hearts. Christmas becomes meaningful when Christ finds a dwelling place within us. The world into which Jesus was born was noisy and crowded—much like ours—but the Savior came quietly because one young woman made room for Him. This December, may we welcome His peace into our conflicts, His hope into our worries, His light into our darkness, and His love into every corner of our lives. When Christ takes shape within us, our celebrations rise above tradition and become true worship.

May the grace shine upon us anew, and may Christ be born in our hearts, our homes, and our church. Wishing every family a blessed Advent and a Christ-filled Christmas.

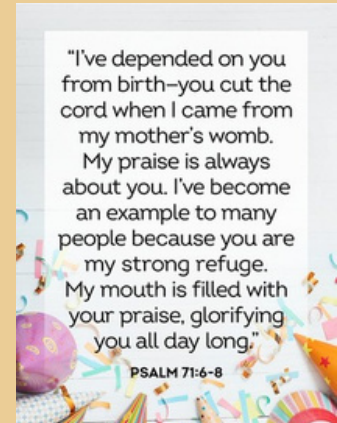
